主旨：有關歐盟預告修正防範中華星天牛 (*Anoplophora chinensis*) 傳入措施草案，評論期至114年5月18日並預計於6月實施案，詳如說明，請查照。

說明：

- 一、依據農業部動植物防疫檢疫署114年4月11日防檢四字第1141881927號函辦理。
- 二、檢送WTO秘書處114年3月19日G/SPS/N/EU/842號通知文件如附，草案重點摘述如下：

(一)明定中華星天牛寄主範圍，包括Acer spp. (槭屬)、Aesculus spp. (七葉樹屬)、Alnus spp. (赤楊屬)、Betula spp. (樺木屬)、Carpinus spp. (鵝耳櫪屬)、Citrus spp. (柑橘屬)、Cornus spp. (山茱萸屬)、Corylus spp. (榛屬)、Cotoneaster spp. (鋪地蜈蚣屬)、Crataegus spp. (山楂屬)、Fagus spp. (山毛櫸屬)、Lagerstroemia spp. (紫薇屬)、Malus spp. (蘋果屬)、Melia spp. (楝屬)、Ostrya

spp. (鐵木屬)、Photinia spp. (石楠屬)、  
Platanus spp. (懸鈴木屬)、Populus spp. (白楊  
屬)、Prunus laurocerasus (桂櫻)、Pyrus spp. (梨  
屬)、Rosa spp. (薔薇屬)、Salix spp. (柳樹屬)、  
Ulmus spp. (榆樹屬)及Vaccinium corymbosum (北方  
高叢藍莓)。

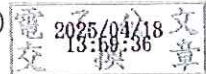
(二)前揭種植用寄主植株須來自中華星天牛的非疫國(區)，  
或在兩年內生長於經認證的非疫生產區，並定期接受檢  
查及採行防治措施，且輸出前須經檢疫確認未罹染中華  
星天牛。

(三)莖部直徑大於1公分之寄主植株須種植於符合規定之非疫  
生產區，並進行定期檢查和採行防治措施。檢查樣本數  
須可偵測到至少1%之有害生物，且該非疫生產區須能有  
效防止中華星天牛入侵或進行有效防治。

三、我國為中華星天牛疫區，請惠予轉知所屬進出口相關業者  
勿逕予輸銷前述寄主植物至歐盟，以免貨品無法順利通  
關。

Description of content:</b> The draft legal act amends the consolidates the EU measures regarding import and internal movement requirements for <i>Anoplophora glabripennis</i> (Motschulsky) <i>Anoplophora chinensis</i> (Forster) in the Annexes of Implementing Regulation (EU) 2019/2072. It amends the scope of host plants subject to measures and establishes the list of countries where the pests are present.
